File an Affidavit of Candidacy in the City Clerk's Office between August 2, & August 16, 2022,
(Monday through Friday, between 8:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m.—
however, the office will be open until 5:00 p.m. August 16th).

- Qualifications**
- Must be a resident of the city at least 30 days before the general election.
 - Must not file for any other office in the same election.
 - Must be a qualified voter in the state of Minnesota.
 - Must be 21 years of age or more when assuming office.
