No Signs in the Right-Of-Way!

Signs are not allowed to be placed on city road right-of-way under state law (Minn. Stat. 160.2715). City right-of-way includes public streets, bridges, medians, bike lanes, sidewalks boulevards and trails. In most cases where sidewalks are present, city right-of-way extends to at least the edge of the sidewalk closest to private property.

Unlawfully placed signs on city right-of-way will be removed and held at the Public Works Building.

The Public Works Building is located at 382 Main Street South. Pick up may be coordinated by calling 507-273-9597.

PUBLIC WORKS—FALL BRUSH & LEAF DUMP EFFECTIVE 10/01/2022

- · Brush, Leaves and Grass Clippings Only, Please.
 - Leaves & Grass Clippings Pile is the lower pile on the right side
 - Trees and Brush Pile is the pile located higher up on the right side
- West on County Rd. 2 at the lights. Take the first gravel road (Mind Drive) on the right after the Root River Bridge. You will find a gate to the dump on the right side of the road.
- Wednesday 1-4 PM, Friday 1-4 PM & Saturday 10 AM—4 PM

For safety purposes, hunting is not allowed on the brush & leaf dump property. The brush & leaf dump will close after the first snowfall.


