Swimming lessons went well. Some tweaks will be made to balance out when lessons are provided versus lap swim availability. May 30 and 31, 2023 would be open for school use with public opening on June 3rd. A deposit is needed for a private pool reservation, perhaps \$100.....add to Fee Schedule.....WSI tuition will be paid only if the student commits to teaching lessons. Sell the ice cream machine.
