

HBC FIBER OPTIC NETWORK CONSTRUCTION



HBC is accelerating construction of the fiber optic network in Chatfield. Work is expected to be completed before the ground freezes in November. Construction crews are working to bury fiber optic cable in public right of ways.

The work will take place in sections according to the following schedule;

- Central— (yellow section on the map) - Complete
- Northwest— (green & purple sections on the

map) - In progress to be completed by mid-September

- West Central (blue section on the map) - Mid-September through mid-October
- East Central & Southeast (red section on the map) - Mid-October through end of the season

As construction in each area is completed, HBC will contact residents when they can have services installed.
