 $\label{eq:continuous} File an Affidavit of Candidacy in the City Clerk's Office between July 30th \& August 13th, 2024 \\ (The office of the City clerk is open from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.)$ 

(On August 13, 2024 the office will be open until 5:00 p.m.)

#### Qualifications

- A resident of the city for 30 days before the general election and has not filed for any other office in the same election.
- Must be a qualified voter in the State of Minnesota.
- · Candidates filing for office must be 21 years of age or more when assuming office.

#### MOTORIZED GOLF CARTS

#### **News Alert!**

Chatfield city council has approved the ordinance 471 to regulate the use of motorized golf carts on the city streets and public areas. Chapter 29 of the City Code of Ordinance will go into affect on <u>August 5th</u>. Application for motorized golf cart tags will be available at city hall. Upon submitting an application be prepared to provide your name and address; copy of valid Minnesota driver's license or reciprocal driving privilege from another jurisdiction; proof of liability insurance providing coverage for the special vehicle.
