# Signs Must Be on Private Property Only



City right-of-way includes public streets, medians, bike lanes, sidewalks bridges, boulevards and trails. Under the Minnesota state law (Minn. Stat. 160.2715) signs are not allowed to be placed on city road right-of-ways.

In most cases where sidewalks are present, city right-of-way extends to at least the edge of the sidewalk closest to private property.

Unlawfully placed signs on city right-of-way will be removed and held at the Public Works Shop. The Public Works Shop is located at 382 Main Street South.



# **Special Vehicle**

News Alert! Chatfield City Council has approved ordinance 472 to regulate the use of special vehicles on city streets. Special vehicles are considered to be all-terrain vehicles, mini trucks, and utility task vehicles. Chapter 27 of the City Code of Ordinance will go into effect on September 19th of 2024.

Upon submitting an application be prepared to provide your name and address; copy of valid Minnesota driver's license or reciprocal driving privilege from another jurisdiction; proof of liability insurance providing coverage for the special vehicle. The owner of a utility task or all-terrain vehicle shall also provide evidence that it is currently registered with the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources.
