Signs Must Be on Private Property Only



In most cases where sidewalks are present, city right-of-way extends to at least the edge of the sidewalk closest to private property.

Unlawfully placed signs on city right-of-way will be removed and held at the Public Works Shop. The Public Works Shop is located at 382 Main Street South.

Pick up may be coordinated by calling 507-867-1511.

City right-of-way includes public streets, bridges, medians, bike lanes, sidewalks boulevards and trails. Under the Minnesota state law (Minn. Stat. 160.2715) signs are not allowed to be placed on city road right-of-ways.

School's Open....Safe Driving, Curfews & Security



Once school starts, people need to be more diligent than ever, when traveling around town. Be aware of increased pedestrian, bicycle and vehicle traffic. Before school, after school and during lunch time are especially busy as in addition to the bus and vehicle traffic, kids are walking and biking to and from school.



Chief of Police, Shane Fox, would like to remind everyone of the local curfew ordinance, as it will be enforced;

16 & under, curfew is 10:00 p.m. Sunday—Thursday and 11:00 p.m. Friday & Saturday.

17 curfew is 11:00 p.m. Sunday—Thursday and 12:00 p.m. on Friday & Saturday. The exceptions from this curfew are for youth in the company of a parent/guardian and for those traveling directly home from work or a school function.

There is NO exception to the curfew ordinance during homecoming week.

The curfew will be enforced throughout the entire year, including homecoming week.



Lock the doors on your home and vehicles (even when parked in your driveway) and keep your garage doors closed.

Most homes and vehicles that have items stolen from them are unlocked. Most items stolen are also visible. If there is nothing visible to steal in your car, thieves usually won't break windows just to check. On the other hand, if you leave your doors unlocked, thieves will open the door and see what they can find. Secure your personal belongings and promptly report unusual activity by calling 9-1-1.

Special Vehicle

News Alert! Chatfield City Council has approved ordinance 472 to regulate the use of special vehicles on city streets. Special vehicles are considered to be all-terrain vehicles, mini trucks, and utility task vehicles. Chapter 27 of the City Code of Ordinance will go into effect on September 19th of 2024.

Upon submitting an application be prepared to provide your name and address; copy of valid Minnesota driver's license or reciprocal driving privilege from another jurisdiction; proof of liability insurance providing coverage for the special vehicle. The owner of a utility task or all-terrain vehicle shall also provide evidence that it is currently registered with the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources.
