# **2024 MUNICIPAL ELECTION RESULTS**

In the City's local election, John McBroom won his re-election bid to continue to serve as the city's mayor, with 825 votes. Congratulations Mayor McBroom!!

In the city council races, congrats go to Josh Broadwater, Dave Frank, and Pam Bluhm as each earned his or her way to the city council, with 1,024 votes, 1011, and 879 votes, respectively. Congratulations to each of you. Thank you for serving your community in this way!!

#### 2025 PROPERTY TAXES AND FEES

Based on the preliminary tax levy that was established by the City Council in September, the City's tax levy will increase by no more than 6.87%. While water and sewer rates will increase next year, garbage rates are not expected to increase. With the water rate increase of 5% and the sewer rate increase of 3%, the estimated Utility Bill on a 5,000gallon per month user is \$140.99 per month.

A public hearing will be held and the final budget and tax levy will be adopted December 9th at 7:00 p.m.

# SHOVEL YOUR SIDEWALKS

Sidewalks need to be cleared of all snow and ice as quickly and completely as possible and at least within 24 hours of the weather event.

- The entire width of the sidewalk must be cleared of snow and ice, down to the concrete.
- Remember to clear curb ramps and crosswalks for wheelchairs and strollers.
- If you are leaving for an extended time, find someone to shovel your walks.

### WINTER PARKING REMINDER

# **PREVENT FROZEN PIPES**

Cold weather can freeze pipes causing them to burst and result in costly repairs.

- Disconnect hoses from your outside faucets and shut off the valve for the outside faucet that is inside your house.
- Keep doors open to rooms that contain plumbing.
- · Ask someone to check your place while you are away.
- · If the temperature of the water collected in a cup after running for 10 minutes is 38 degrees or below start running your water with a stream the diameter of a pencil and notify City Hall at 507-867-3810 so water bills can be adjusted accordingly.
