- Demonstrating courteous behavior/attitude toward your surroundings, other outdoor users, landowners and lawmakers.

DOG-WALKING ETIQUETTE

Did you get your pet license?

Following a few ground rules will help keep pets & people safe:

- Use a Leash. While dogs may have excellent recall, there's no telling what might trigger them to bolt or involve them in a contentious situation with another dog or a person. Even though the city ordinance language states that your dog must be under your control at heel by command or leash, having your dog off leash is risky and may make others uncomfortable.
- Be Respectful. This goes for people and property alike. Don't let your dog run up to or jump on other people; keep them close to you so others can pass you without the fear of falling. Also, keep them off neighborhood lawns. Landscaping is expensive and time-consuming, and dog pee is a lawn killer.
- Pick Up Your Dog's Poop. It is unlawful to permit a dog (or cat) to defecate on any private property without consent or on any public property unless immediately removed and placed in a proper receptacle.



CHATFIELD COMMUNITY GARDEN

If you have always wanted a garden and you don't have space on your property, we have exciting news. There will be community garden space located at 1646 Enterprise Drive SE that will be available to the public.

Each person desiring to use a community garden plot must complete an application, submit a fee and agree to adhere to the regulations annually. Generally, the plot availability will be from May 15th to October 15th, depending on weather conditions. Initially, 4 plots will be available. If there is interest for more than 4 plots, accommodations can be made for up to 10 plots. The cost for each 20' x 30' plot will be \$30 this year. There is a designated parking area, do not drive on grass. Plots are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Provide the following: (Form available on-line or at city hall)

- Garden Sign Up Sheet
- Garden Rules and Regulations Sheet signed
- Cash/Check/Card Payable to City of Chatfield

Payment must be made in full to reserve a garden plot.
