Swimming Pool Project

The swimming pool referendum was approved by voters on a 237—196 vote on November 7th. Although the referendum does authorize the issuance of up to \$4,402,000 of bonds to finance the construction of a new facility, there are many decisions to be made prior to actually constructing a new pool. An actual project budget will be developed that will determine the maximum dollar amount that the City Council is willing to allocate for the project, certain items might be designated as private fundraising goals, and a timeline for the project needs to be developed. In the meantime, action will be taken to survey the site and to analyze the soil conditions of the proposed site. Because the new facility is planned for a slightly different location, it is not anticipated that the community will lose a season of swimming pool services. We will make every effort to keep you informed as this project moves forward.

CCTV

As people may or may not be aware, the City's Cable Television Administrator, Craig Manahan, is slated to enter into retirement on January 1st. At the time of this writing, no one has been identified to take his place, although efforts are continuing in that regard. CCTV has developed into a point of great pride for the community as the service provides a great deal of entertainment and information to the public. The City values the community-connections that are made possible because of CCTV, and has every intention of continuing the service as well as possible. We will keep you posted.



Winter Reminders—Sidewalks need to be cleared as quickly and completely as possible after a snowfall. **No parking on city streets when plows are operating.** Parking tickets will be issued and cars may be towed if parked cars interfere with snowplowing or removal.
