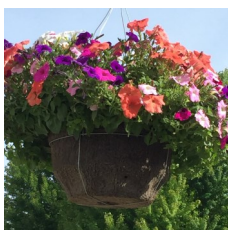

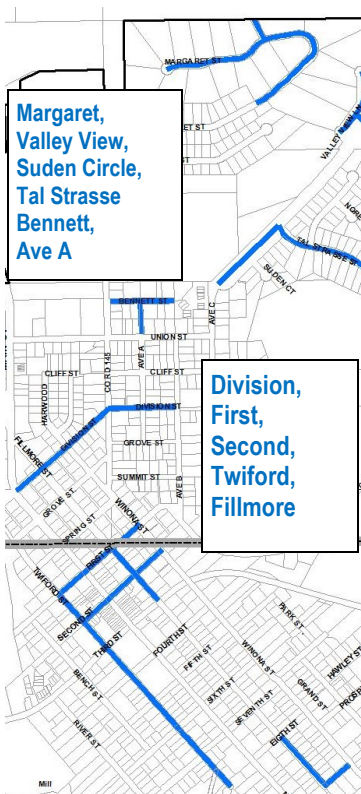

## Street Maintenance...Chip Sealing



Starting Monday, July 10th, the Public Works department will be chip sealing the streets shown in blue on the map.

Pearson Brothers will be applying a thin layer of oil to the road surface and then cover with a layer of granite rock chips over the top of the oil. A roller is used to pack the rock down to help it stick to the oil. It is recommended to leave the excess rock down for up to 4 weeks before sweeping. We will begin sweeping the excess rock up on August 1st.

Please remove all vehicles from the streets by sunrise Monday, July 10th through the end of the day on July 12th and then again on August 1st for sweeping. "No Parking" signs will be put out the night before to help remind everyone that work will be taking place.

If vehicles are not removed by the morning of July 10th-July 12th, they will be towed so the job can be completed properly.

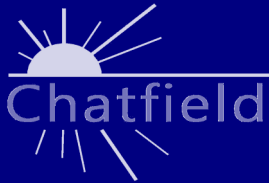


