Swimming Pool Referendum

A referendum will be held on Tuesday, November 7th, regarding the construction of a new swimming pool. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m.—8:00 p.m. and voting will take place at the Thurber Community Building (City Hall), which is located at 21 Second Street SE. The City Clerk's office will also be open from 10:00-3:00 on Saturday, November 4th and until 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 6th, so people can cast absentee ballots. Absentee ballots can be obtained during regular business hours, at the City Clerk's office.



The proposal is to construct a new pool facility, located on the grounds of the High School, across the access drive from the tennis courts. The pool would be approximately 6,300 square feet in size and include a waterslide, a 1-meter diving board, zero depth entry, shade features, a bath house, etc. A drawing of the proposal is available for viewing in the City Council Chambers. The referendum, if successful, would authorize the City to issue up to \$4,402,000 of bonds to pay for the improvements. Please vote.

Opportunities to Serve, Please Help!

Please consider serving your community on either the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) or the Planning & Zoning (P&Z) Commission. The HPC Commission has two open seats and the P&Z Commission has one vacancy.

The Historic Preservation Commission is a group of seven that is charged with assisting in the preservation of historic and/or architecturally significant buildings, structures and sites in the city. This group has commissioned studies to identify potentially historic buildings, they have conducted an oral history project and they have participated in reconstructing a significant piece of art in the community. The HPC meets on the second Monday in January, March, May, July, September and November at 7:00 p.m. in the board room of the Historic Potter Auditorium.

The Planning & Zoning Commission is made up of seven residents who plan for the development and character of the community. Their work involves monthly meetings that are designed to plan for the future physical growth of the community and to consider the appropriate uses of the land within the city. They also deal with zoning code variances, conditional use permits and development of plans. The P&Z meets the first Monday of each month in the Council Chambers at the Thurber Community Building.
