Chief of Police, Shane Fox, would like to remind everyone of the local curfew ordinance, as it will be enforced....

16 & under, curfew is 10:00 p.m. Sunday—Thursday and 11:00 p.m. Friday & Saturday.

17 curfew is 11:00 p.m. Sunday—Thursday and 12:00 p.m. on Friday & Saturday.

The exceptions from this curfew are for youth in the company of a parent/guardian and for those traveling directly home from work or a school function. *There is NO exception to the curfew ordinance during Homecoming Week* and the curfew will be enforced throughout the entire year, including Homecoming week.



Personal Security: Lock the doors on your home, keep the garage doors closed and lock your vehicles, even when they are parked in your driveway.

Most homes and vehicles that have items stolen from them are unlocked. Most items stolen are also visible. You can safely assume that if there is nothing visible to steal in your car thieves won't break windows just to check. On the other hand, if you leave your doors unlocked, thieves will open the door and see what they can find. Secure your personal belongings and promptly report unusual activity by calling 9-1-1.
