Currently, Russell Smith serves as Mayor, while Paul Novotny and Mike Urban fill the City Council seats that will be up for election.



Parade Route Change

Due to the street and utility improvements that are being made in Bench Street and Twiford Street areas, the Western Days parade route will change!!

This year, the parade route will begin at the corner of Main Street and Spring Street, travel south to Fifth Street, turn left to Fillmore Street, and then north on Fillmore, finishing at the corner of Fillmore and Highway 74/30.
