FROM: BRIAN BURKHOLDER, WATER SUPERINTENDENT SUBJECT: COLD DRINKING WATER

Due to the extreme cold conditions of this winter, residents of the city are advised to test the temperature of their drinking water. If the temperature is below 40 degrees, it would be advisable to run water continuously to avoid water pipes from freezing. In order to properly test your water, run water continuously for approximately three minutes and then insert a small thermometer that is typically hung in a freezer or used in an aquarium. Running water with a stream the diameter of a pencil is generally sufficient to avoid freezing but, the farther your water temperature falls below 40, the stronger the stream needs to be. Once the water temperature falls below 40, it is likely that you will need to run that water until the ground thaws in the spring.

#### **EVERY DROP COUNTS**

Correcting household leaks can save homeowners an average of more than 10,000 gal of water per year, or the amount of water in a typical backyard swimming pool. Finding and fixing leaks around the home can be as simple as check, twist and replace:

- **Check** toilets for leaks by putting a few drops of food coloring into the tank; wait a few minutes and see if color appears in the bowl before you flush. If it does, there is a leak.
- **Twist** on a new WaterSense labeled faucet aerator or showerhead, and tighten hose and pipe connections.
- Replace fixtures if necessary with WaterSense labeled models, which are independently certified to use 20% less water and perform as well or better than standard models.
