17 curfew is 11:00 p.m. Sunday—Thursday and 12:00 p.m. on Friday & Saturday.

The exceptions from this curfew are for youth in the company of a parent/guardian and for those traveling directly home from work or a school function. There is NO exception to the curfew ordinance during Homecoming Week and the curfew will be enforced throughout the entire year, including Homecoming

and personal items stolen.


