### Pool Closure Policies

**Temperature** If the noon temperature is not at least 66 degrees according to the Rochester International Airport, the pool will not open for the afternoon session. Opening for the evening session will be re-evaluated at 6:30 pm. Exemptions will apply for swimming lessons, water aerobics and family swim.

**Storms** If a severe thunderstorm or tornado warning is issued for either Fillmore or Olmsted county the pool will close immediately. If thunder is heard or lightning seen by staff the pool will immediately close until one half hour after the last thunder is heard or flash of lightning is seen. If it is after 3 pm the pool will close for the remainder of that session. If it is after 7:45 pm the pool will close for the night. If heavy rains are present, the pool will clear until the rain has passed.

**Attendance** If there are people at the pool at 1:00 the pool will open. If 10 people are not at the pool by 2:00 p.m. the pool will close for the afternoon. If 10 people are not at the pool by 7:50 the pool will close for the night.

**Unsafe Condition(s)** If a condition that is not safe is found, the pool will close until the situation is corrected, or directed by the state health department standards.

**Pool closure is at the discretion of the Pool Manager or Head Guard.**

**WARNING SIRENS**

The City has recently entered into an agreement with Olmsted County to test, maintain and activate the outdoor warning sirens in Chatfield. The purpose of the sirens is to warn people who are outdoors—while it is common for people within houses and other buildings to hear these sirens, it is actually expected that people indoors will be warned in other more effective ways, such as radio, television or special weather radio.

**Siren Testing**

- **Apr 1-Oct 1** Full 3 min every Wednesday
- **Oct 2—May 31**, First Wednesday of the month 1 min.  
All other Wednesday's a quiet test

Tests will not be conducted if there is rain or bad weather in the area.

**Siren Activation**

1. Winds 70 mph or more
2. Tornado Warning by NWS
3. Spotted funnel cloud by trained spotter
4. Radar detected funnel cloud
