# THE STATE BUDGET EFFECT...

Although the exact details of the State's budget deal are not yet known, the City has learned that it will receive approximately \$113,000 less in Local Government Aid than what the State had previously certified to the City. The City had anticipated this when setting its 2011 budget, though, so this should not affect typical operations of the City. Since these dollars had been earmarked to be placed in the wastewater treatment plant debt service fund, there will not be as much sewer rate relief as had been hoped for.


